

VILLAGE OF LOMIRA ORDINANCE #319, REGULATION OF OUTSIDE BURNING HEATING SYSTEMS

The Village Board of the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin, do ordain the following:

Sec. 12-216 REGULATION OF OUTSIDE BURNING HEATING SYSTEMS

1. Purpose. This section is intended to promote the public health, safety and welfare and to safeguard the health, comfort, and living conditions, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lomira.
2. Applies to outside burning heating systems installed prior to adoption of original ordinance in 1999
 - (a) Outdoor burning heating systems in use prior to the adoption of original ordinance in 1999 shall be grandfathered in until the end of their lifecycle and cannot be replaced. Outdoor burning heating systems that were installed and in use prior to the adoption of original ordinance shall be registered at the office of the Village clerk. Registration will include the make, model and serial number if available.
 1. The owners of outdoor burning heating systems shall obtain an annual permit from the Village clerk and/or building inspector.
 - (b) All outdoor burning heating systems existing prior to adoption of original ordinance must be inspected by the Fire Chief and/or Building Inspector for safety concerns and Building Code violations.
4. Existing outdoor burning heating systems shall comply with the following:
 - (a) The outdoor burning heating system shall have a chimney that extends a minimum of 20 feet above the ground surface. If there are any residences within 200 feet the chimney shall also extend at least 15 feet above the structure housing the wood burner.
5. Materials that may not be burned:
 - Wet or freshly cut wood.
 - Rubbish or garbage, including but not limited to, food wastes, food wraps, packaging, animal carcasses, paint or painted materials, furniture, composite shingles, construction or demolition debris or other household or business wastes.
 - Waste oil or other oily wastes.
 - Asphalt or products containing asphalt.
 - Treated or painted wood, including plywood, composite wood products or other wood products that are painted, varnished or treated with preservatives.
 - Any plastic material, including nylon, PVC, ABS, polystyrene or urethane foam, synthetic fabrics, plastic films and plastic containers.
 - Rubber, including tires and synthetic rubber-like products.
 - Newspaper, corrugated cardboard, container board, office paper and other materials the must be recycled.
6. This section does not apply to the following:
 - Grilling or cooking using a charcoal, wood, propane or natural gas in cooking appliances.
 - Burning in a stove, furnace, fireplace or other heating device within a building used for human or animal habitation.
 - The use of propane, acetylene, natural gas, gasoline or kerosene in a device intended for heating, construction, or maintenance activities.


