

ORDINANCE NO. 318

An Ordinance to Recodify the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Lomira, Wisconsin

The Village Board of the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin, do ordain the following:

WHEREAS, it was deemed expedient and necessary that the general ordinances of the Village of Lomira, Wisconsin, be revised, recodified and arranged in appropriate chapters, sections and subsections, that omissions be supplied, defects be amended and new ordinances be enacted; and, that the same be published in book form and available online to make the whole thereof plain, concise, intelligible and convenient; and,

WHEREAS, ordinances adopted through January 1, 2021, along with amendments and changes necessitated by recommendation of the Village have now been arranged in appropriate chapters, sections and subsections with same being incorporated into the recodified "Code of Ordinances" for the Village; and

THEREFORE, the Board of the Village of Lomira do ordain as follows:

1. That the recodified Code of Ordinances for the Village, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Village Clerk-Treasurer for public inspection and available on the Village of Lomira website, shall be and the same are hereby adopted as the "Code of Ordinances" in and for the Village of Lomira, Wisconsin
2. That the "Code of Ordinances" in and for the Village of Lomira shall have the force of law and shall remain in force until repealed
3. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as provided by law.
